### ACADEMIC PROBATION OR SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION ON THE BASIS OF GPA:

Students must maintain a 2.000 average or better for all work undertaken in the university (overall and quarterly).

### ACADEMIC PROBATION OR SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION ON THE BASIS OF INADEQUATE PROGRESS:

Minimum progress is an average of 12 units completed per quarter calculated at the end of each quarter.
